Children Younger than 10 Need Two Doses of the H1N1 Flu Vaccine for Full Protection

Summit County, Ohio: The Summit County, Barberton, and Akron Health Departments join together to remind parents and health care providers that children younger than 10 years of age should receive two doses of the H1N1 influenza vaccine in order to achieve optimal protection against pandemic flu. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends children younger than 10 receive two doses of the H1N1 vaccine that are separated by 28 days. Ohioans 10 years and older only need one dose to be protected. Children younger than six months cannot receive influenza vaccine. All persons caring for a child under six months old are encouraged to get vaccinated. Listed below are the upcoming H1N1 vaccination clinics in Summit County.
